FortisBC construction activities

Dear neighbour,

FortisBC is upgrading 20 kilometres of natural gas line in Vancouver, Burnaby and Coquitlam. The new line will improve the reliability of the system while increasing capacity as Lower Mainland communities continue to grow.

Our crews are working in your neighbourhood

Beginning as early as the week of June 18th, crews will be installing fencing on Graveley Street from Boundary Road to the recently constructed Valiant Way in preparation for installing the new gas line. Construction activities are anticipated to be complete by early September in this area. Valiant Way was constructed to allow access to Graveley Street and Kootenay Street from East 1st Ave and to maintain access to nearby businesses, and the VPD.

To safely perform the construction work, a full closure is necessary on this portion of Graveley Street, with the exception of a short section for local traffic only on the northern lanes of Graveley Street. Please refer to the map on the second page for the location of Valiant Way, and the traffic impacts on Graveley Street.

Traffic control signs and traffic personnel will help to safely direct pedestrian and vehicle traffic into nearby businesses. Businesses will remain open during construction. We are working with business owners to let them know about any changes to access.

Construction hours will be Monday-Saturday 7:00am – 8:00pm, as well as limited work on Sundays if required. There may also be overnight work required. During this time, nearby businesses and residents will experience noise impacts and traffic delays associated with this project.
